When Robert Borden's Conservatives won the general election of September 1911, the Navy was in a state of crisis. Ships from Hell. Only a year later, when North Korea attacked the South, Canada quickly dispatched three destroyers to the region and maintained that number on station and in rotation for the duration of the war, a major accomplishment for a destroyer force of only eight ships.

The maritime component was named Maritime Command. On 7 May it was announced by the Navy that each major naval reserve unit would help meet the growing demand for technically skilled sailors within the fleet by training personnel in specialist skills.

When the Royal Canadian Navy was formed on 4 May there was no corresponding naval reserve.
